- Would like to hear about the difference between working in commercial and charity organisations








Private Investigation (Insurance) with Michael Bott

...are keen to learn about a possible career in law.










Marketing/Technology/Communication with Jonathan Griffiths

 want to see how a career evolves and how important it is to embrace change and build resilience. (Focus on soft skills)










NHS Clinical Psychologist – Healthcare with Dr Clare Henderson
