Ahead of the final exams, here is a summary of the key messages from the parent information evening that took place on Tuesday 1st April:

- The Easter holiday revision timetable has been issued- it would be fantastic to see as many pupils as possible at these sessions
- Students will be issued an 'Exit timetable when they return, detailing:
 1. Locations of 8am 'warm ups'
 2. Locations of booster sessions (adapted period 6 lessons)
 3. Locations of lessons which replace those in subjects which are already completed
- We would appreciate your support in ensuring students arrive to exam 'warm ups' a couple of minutes before the start time, so that entry isn't disrupted

- Weekly homework books will be issued on Wednesday 30th April, ahead of the first tutor check during roll call on Tuesday 6th May
- Keep revision planners prominent in terms of visibility- make it a frequent topic of conversation
- Remind students that revision should now be in the form of practice papers- 'open book' to start, exam conditions as we approach the final exams

We would like to wish all parents and students a restful Easter and look forward to returning to a highly focussed lead into the GCSE exams.
