Château d'Eblinghem is set in a rural location just 8km east of St Omer on the Opal Coast in Northern France. Students will be immersed into the French culture. They will gain insight into French farming and take part in a cheese tasting; visit the Le Touquet Lighthouse and the surrounding area.



With a visit to La Cite Souterraine de Naours, students will explore the underground city of Naours, a maze of 28 tunnels and 300 chambers as well as take on the challenge of the Tree Climbing Park. Students will also take part in a French bakery workshop, where students will have a chance to make traditional French bread and croissants

Any cancellations made 14 days or less before departure will incur a 100% charge of the tour cost.
