WHAT ARE T LEVELS?

T Levels are a new employer led qualification equal to three A Levels. Available to school leavers after they have completed their GSCEs

KEY FACTS ABOUT T LEVELS:

- Combines classroom (80%) and a work placement (20%)
- 315 Hours (9 weeks) on industry placements over the 2 years
- Designed by businesses and employers to get you work ready
- Two-year full-time study programme

ARE T LEVELS RIGHT FOR ME?

T Levels will give you a range of options, including gaining knowledge and experience to get skilled employment, moving onto an apprenticeship or progressing to higher education. Our Entry requirements are 5 GSCEs at grade 4 or above, including English and Maths*

CAN I GO TO UNIVERSITY AFTER T LEVELS?

Yes. T Levels get you work ready, or you can also continue with a degree. UCAS points have been allocated to T Levels so they are the equivalent to three A Levels:

UCAS tariff points	T Level overall grade	A Level equivalent
168	Distinction*	A*A*A*
144	Distinction	AAA
120	Merit	BBB
96	Pass (C or above on core component)	ccc
72	Pass (D or E on core component)	DDD



HOW DOES A T LEVEL WORK?

80% classroom learning

20% industry placement

Core curriculum

- Learn concepts, theories and principles of general subject
- Assessed through an external examination and a substantial project

Specialism

- Opportunity to specialise within chosen course
- Develop knowledge and skills needed for a job in that area
- At least half of the classroom time

English and maths

- If not achieved, work towards these qualifications
- •Also any digital skills relevant to the course



- •Spend at least 20% of the course on placement
- •With a real employer
- Generally unpaid, but travel and subsistence costs may be available
