WHAT ARE T LEVELS?

T Levels are a new employer led qualification equal to three A Levels. Available to school leavers after they have completed their GCSEs

KEY FACTS ABOUT T LEVELS:

- Combines classroom (80%) and a work placement (20%)
- 315 Hours (9 weeks) on industry placements over the 2 years
- Designed by businesses and employers to get you work ready
- Two-year full-time study programme

ARE T LEVELS RIGHT FOR ME?

T Levels will give you a range of options, including gaining knowledge and experience to get skilled employment, moving onto an apprenticeship or progressing to higher education. Our Entry requirements are 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and Maths*


CAN I GO TO UNIVERSITY AFTER T LEVELS?

Yes. T Levels get you work ready, or you can also continue with a degree. UCAS points have been allocated to T Levels so they are the equivalent to three A Levels:

UCAS tariff points	T Level overall grade	A Level equivalent
168	Distinction*	A*A*A*
144	Distinction	AAA
120	Merit	BBB
96	Pass (C or above on core component)	CCC
72	Pass (D or E on core component)	DDD
