



Broadwater School Uniform

Broadwater School requires pupils / students to wear school uniform. We believe that a school uniform provides a sense of belonging and identity whilst setting an appropriate tone for an education setting.

In developing our school uniform, we have carefully considered what is required practically for classroom lessons or for sport, safeguarding and health and safety considerations, and our obligations under the Equality Act 2010, and we have taken account of the wishes of parents and pupils.

We have also considered the cost implications for families and different groups of pupils and sought best value - we have minimised the number of branded items and the vast majority of our uniform can be purchased from different suppliers so that parents have a choice of where they can shop. We will avoid frequent uniform changes so that clothes can be passed on. We also offer second hand uniform through our [Friends of Broadwater](#) to ensure that families have low cost options.
