I would like to signpost a few events that are coming up in the school year:

We have **Year 11 Mock Interviews** coming up on **Friday 21st November**. Students will start to look at how to prepare CVs and cover letters during social science time and will be building their CVs via the [Unifrog platform](#). They can record any 'Activities' (experiences of work, academic and extracurricular projects, personal responsibilities) and 'Skills' they've built in their [Unifrog](#) accounts and these will be useful in helping them to build their CVs.
